He inspired us to continue the work of fostering hope and changing lives.

This year, the recipients of our annual awards were:

Jackie Bradford: The Barnabas Servant Leader Award. This award was created in 2018 by the Agape Board and is the highest award given for lifetime service. It can be awarded to anyone in our community.

Michael and Elise White: The Good Samaritan Award. This award recognizes parents who have gone above and beyond for children placed in their home during the year. They have shown selflessness in parenting, relationship-building with birth families, working with community partners and, overall, living as examples of Agape love.

James Hutcheson III: The Dot Landers Service Award. This award honors individuals who have significantly contributed to forwarding Agape's mission, while being an example of faith and service to the community. Honorees are selected from Agape's base of strong supporters, volunteers, staff, and foster families.
